POWESHIEK COUNTY ORDINANCE #14

TITLE: An Ordinance Establishing a One Percent (1%) Local Option Sales and Services Tax Upon Transactions Occurring On or After July 1, 2007 and that imposition of such tax shall continue through June 30, 2027 within the incorporated areas of Barnes City, Brooklyn, Deep River, Guernsey, Grinnell, Hartwick, Malcom, Montezuma, Searsboro and Victor of Poweshiek County, Iowa.

PURPOSE: There is imposed a Local Option Sales and Services Tax applicable to transactions within the incorporated areas of Barnes City, Brooklyn, Deep River, Guernsey, Grinnell, Hartwick, Malcom, Montezuma, Searsboro, and Victor of Poweshiek County, Iowa. The rate of tax shall be one percent (1%) upon the gross receipts taxed under Chapter 423B, subchapter II-Local Option Taxes, of the Iowa Code in the incorporated areas of Barnes City, Brooklyn, Deep River, Guernsey, Grinnell, Hartwick, Malcom, Montezuma, Searsboro and Victor, Poweshiek County, Iowa.

Be It Enacted by the Board of Supervisors of Poweshiek County, Iowa:

Section 1. Local Option Sales and Services Tax. There is imposed a Local Option and Sales Services Tax applicable to transactions with the incorporated areas of Barnes City, Brooklyn, Deep River, Guernsey, Grinnell, Hartwick, Malcom, Montezuma, Searsboro, and Victor, Poweshiek County, Iowa.

The rate of tax shall be one percent (1%) upon the gross receipts taxed under Chapter 423B, subchapter II- Local Option Taxes of the Iowa Code in the incorporated areas of Barnes City, Brooklyn, Deep River, Guernsey, Grinnell, Hartwick, Malcom, Montezuma, Searsboro and Victor, Poweshiek County, Iowa.

The local sales/services tax is imposed on transactions occurring on or after July 1, 2007 and that imposition of such tax shall continue through June 30, 2027 within the incorporated areas of Barnes City, Brooklyn, Deep River, Guernsey, Grinnell, Hartwick, Malcom, Montezuma, Searsboro and Victor, Poweshiek County Iowa. All persons required to collect state gross receipts taxes shall collect the tax. However, the tax shall not be imposed on the gross receipts from the sale of motor fuel or special fuel as defined in Chapter 452A of the Iowa Code, on gross receipts from the rental of rooms, apartments, or sleeping quarters which are taxed under chapter 423A of the Iowa Code during the period the hotel and motel tax is imposed, on the gross receipts from the sale of natural gas or electric energy in a city or county where the gross receipts are subject are subject to a franchise fee or user fee or user fee during the period the franchise or user fee is imposed, on the gross receipts from the sale of a lottery ticket or share in a lottery game conducted pursuant to chapter 99G of the Iowa Code, and on the sale or rental of tangible personal property described in section 423.45 of the Iowa Code.

All applicable provisions of the appropriate sections of Chapter 423, of the Iowa Code are adopted by reference.

Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be in effect after its final passage, approval and publication by law.
