

DIAMOND LAKE CAMPING SEASON

CAMPING AT DIAMOND LAKE PARK IS PERMITTED ALL YEAR. CAMPERS ARE ONLY ALLOWED TO STAY TWO WEEKS AND THEN NEED TO VACATE THE PARK FOR 48 HOURS BEFORE COMING BACK.

ELECTRICITY WILL REMAIN ON YEAR-AROUND IN THE DIAMOND LAKE CAMPGROUNDS. THE FACILITIES WILL BE OPENED AND CLOSED AND WATER TURNED ON AND OFF WHEN THE WEATHER DICTATES.

THE CONSERVATION BOARD HAS A SELF-REGISTRATION SYSTEM. YOU MUST REGISTER AT ONE OF THE THREE BOOTHS AND DEPOSIT YOUR CAMPING FEES THERE.

\$20.00 PER NIGHT FOR AN ELECTRIC SITE

**\$10.00 PER NIGHT FOR A PRIMITIVE SITE
