Dust control will not be placed prior to May 15th. Soft road conditions in the spring may cause Poweshiek County to restrict placement to a later date. We will call when the area is ready for you to put on your application. One purpose of this permit is to give the Poweshiek County Highway Department two (2) weeks advance notice so that we can prepare the roadway for dust control. Most dust control products are placed twice in a season. A separate permit is not required for the second application in the season, but the same two (2) week notice must be provided for the second application to allow Poweshiek County to prepare the road. Preparations may include placing rock and/or blading the road. The permit applicant is responsible for the payment, application and maintenance of the dust control. If an asphaltic material is used it shall be covered with a chip seal immediately after placement. "Fresh Oil" signs shall be placed during the time period when the dust control product can be picked up by car tires. The applicant is responsible for any damage to vehicles caused by the dust control. The dust control location shall be marked with four 12" x 12" orange flags at all corners at the end of the dust control area.

The other purpose of this permit is to ensure that the roadway is maintained. Iowa law specifies that the purpose of a public highway is to serve the traveling public. The permit applicant is responsible for keeping the road free of chuckholes by filling them as soon as they develop. Poweshiek County reserves the right to scarify the road if the county feels that proper maintenance has not been applied. Poweshiek County also reserves the right to scarify and blade the road thoroughly after October 15th without notice so as to prepare for winter.
