

POWESHIEK COUNTY DUST CONTROL POLICY April 13, 1995

Dust Control Service:

1. Shall apply for a yearly permit to provide dust control to customers along Poweshiek County roads. The permit must state the method of dust control. Permit forms are available at the County Engineer's Office. This permit will be valid until October 15th of each permit year.
2. Shall provide to Poweshiek County a current typewritten list of all customers, length of dust control, location (section, township, E911 address) and phone number. This list must be kept current at all times.
3. Shall measure each customer's dust control area and mark the area with two (2) flags. These flags must be orange in color, at least 12 inches by 12 inches in size, and attached to a staff made of wood lathe or plastic at least 36 inches long. These flags are to be located just off the right side of the roadway surface as traffic approaches the dust control area.
4. Shall notify Poweshiek County at least three (3) days before the initial application or any subsequent application of any dust control product to the roadway.
5. Shall provide each customer a copy of the current Poweshiek County Dust Control Policy.

Customer:

1. Shall maintain the flags provided to mark the dust control area. Flags must be erect and visible at all times.
2. Shall be responsible for maintaining the dust control area by filling any holes that may develop as soon as possible, and within three (3) days when notified by Poweshiek County.
3. Shall understand that after October 15th of each year, dust control areas are routinely bladed as a normal preparation for winter. Dust control areas may also be maintained at any time deemed necessary for the convenience of travelers on the public road. Poweshiek County will not be responsible for the loss of effectiveness of the dust control treatment.
4. Shall be responsible to notify Poweshiek County of any problems that develop in the dust control area.
5. Shall assume full responsibility for any and all liability resulting from this dust control material placed upon the public highway.

6. Shall understand that by purchasing the dust control service, the customer agrees to abide by the conditions stated in this document.

Poweshiek County:

1. Shall provide preliminary maintenance to the roadway to receive the initial and any subsequent dust control applications within three (3) days of the notification of the site to be treated, weather permitting.
2. Shall notify customers when maintenance is required to be performed to a dust control area before the October 15th date.
