Lyle stated he had received a phone call from the railroad attorney making an offer of \$200,000 cash to be paid by the end of 2016, the railroad will provide a flagger, which is required by federal law. The railroad wants the County to take future responsibility for the bridge. Lyle stated the County has not accepted or rejected the offer. Lamoyne said the County needs to consider the impact it would have on other Counties if they take the bridge. Lyle discussed possible timelines and procedure. Lyle said the County has established a committee to consider the offer, and will come up with a formal agreement to be presented to the Board. Lyle said he will report back if there are any significant events.
