Important dates for City/School Election:

- Election Day – November 5, 2019; polls will be open 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
- Voter Pre-Registration deadline – October 25, 2019
- Last day to mail absentee ballots – October 25, 2019
- In-person absentee voting ends November 4, 2019 at 5:00 p.m.

How can you vote before Election Day?

- Vote by mail by submitting an absentee ballot request form. Forms must be received by October 25, 2019. Call our office at 641-623-5443 and request a request form be mailed to you or locate online at <https://sos.iowa.gov/elections/pdf/absenteeballotapp.pdf>
- Vote in our office at 302 E. Main St., Montezuma, IA from October 7 to November 4. Regular business hours are Monday – Friday 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

How can you be ready on Election Day?

- Check your voter registration at <https://sos.iowa.gov/elections/voterreg/regtovote/search.aspx>
- Need to update your voter registration? Call our office at 641-623-5443 and request to have a form mailed to you or register online or locate form online at <https://sos.iowa.gov/elections/voterinformation/voterregistration.html>
- Find your polling location <https://sos.iowa.gov/elections/voterinformation/electionday.html>
- ID is required at your polling location. Acceptable ID's are:
 - Iowa Driver's License/Iowa Non-operator ID (not expired more than 90 days)
 - U.S. Passport (not expired)
 - U.S. Military or Veteran ID (not expired)
 - Iowa Voter Identification Card (must be signed)
 - Tribal ID Card/Document (must be signed, with photo, not expired)
- Iowa has Election Day Registration and attestation options.
