Moved by Bolen, 2nd by Roudabush to approve certificate of appointment for Steve Kivi, Chief Deputy Sheriff, Sheriff's Office, effective January 2, 2025; rate of pay \$46.16 per hour plus \$3.46 per hour stipend chief deputy pay. 3 aves. Motion carried.

8:35 a.m. Sandy Ross, Treasurer met with board to discuss proposed FY26 budget for the motor vehicle, driver license and tax departments.

Tindle inquired with Ross about recent closures of the driver license office. Ross stated she was training the employees in that office for back-up for issuing checks for payroll or accounts payable in case of the absence of herself or other staff member capable of issuing said checks. Tindle would like to see at least one of the employees remain in the driver license office in order to keep it open or as an alternative place a sign on the door indicating that individuals can check in at the tax office.

Moved by Bolen, 2nd by Roudabush to approve Resolution #2025-18 approving public officers' bonds pursuant to Iowa Code Chapter 64. 3 ayes. Motion carried.

RESOLUTION #2025-18 BOND APPROVAL PURSUANT TO IOWA CODE CHAPTER 64

WHEREAS. Iowa Code Chapter 64 requires public officers to obtain bond; and

WHEREAS, Iowa Code Section 64.8 requires members of boards of supervisors, county attorneys, recorders, auditors, sheriffs, and assessors to obtain a bond in a sum of no less than twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000); and **WHEREAS**, Iowa Code Section 64.10 requires treasurer to obtain bond in a sum not less than fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000); and

WHEREAS, Iowa Code Section 64.11 requires that the reasonable cost of said bond be paid by the county where the bond is filed; and

WHEREAS, Iowa Code Section 331.324(6) allows that a blanket surety bond insuring the fidelity of county officers and employees who are accountable for county funds or property subject to the minimum surety bond requirements of Chapter 64; and

WHEREAS, all bonds required by law shall be construed as impliedly containing the conditions required by the statue, anything in the terms of said bonds to be the contrary notwithstanding; and

WHEREAS, the county supervisors, county attorney, county recorder, county auditor, county sheriff, county assessor, and county treasurer have obtained appropriate blanket bonds meeting the requirements of Iowa Code Chapter 64 and Iowa Code 331.324(6).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the surety bonds set forth above are hereby approved pursuant to Iowa Code Section 64.19.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Poweshiek County Auditor shall record said bond and this approval order pursuant to Iowa Code Section 64.24.
